

Extension of the Partnership Agreement

between

Chulalongkorn University Bangkok and Leopold-Franzens University Innsbruck

to the

University of Vienna / Austria und the University of Chiang Mai / Thailand

Preamble

The partnership agreement between the Leopold-Franzens-University Innsbruck and the Chulalongkorn University Bangkok/ Thailand signed almost ten years ago has led to a most fruitful cooperation between these two institutions. This flourishing partnership has given rise to the strong wish that other universities in Austria and Thailand join in this agreement. Both partner universities welcome this development and are in favour of an extension, as they believe that an extension of further opportunities for cooperation in teaching and research will be to the benefit of all parties concerned.

The Partnership Agreement between Chulalongkorn University and Leopold-Franzens University Innsbruck

Acting on behalf of their respective Universities, the Rectors of the University of Innsbruck and Chulalongkorn University, after meaningful discussion of possible future academic contributions of both Universities, as well as in continuation of their past and present spirit of co-operation, do hereby agree to the following:

- (1) The existing academic co-operation between both Universities is mutually welcomed and should also be continued and further enhanced.*
- (2) An exchange of faculty members in areas of teaching and/or research programs in all appropriated fields should be encouraged.*
- (3) Co-operation in post-graduate studies should be promoted.*
- (4) Relevant information and publications in science and research should be freely exchanged.*
- (5) Scientists and research workers should be provided with all necessary facilities for carrying out their studies, teaching and/or research at the two Universities, in accordance with the legal provisions of both countries.*
- (6) Support for this co-operative exchange program should be sought through established exchange programs, scholarships, University funds and/or other legally established procedures provided for such activities by either each University and/ or its government.*
- (7) Other kinds of academic co-operation may, in future, also be mutually agreed upon.*

This Agreement on Academic Co-operation shall enter into force upon the formal exchange of notes of approval by the respective authorities of both parties and shall, moreover, continue to be in force for an indefinite period unless terminated upon written notification by either University, with termination being effective six months after the date of notification.


Extension of the Partnership

The Leopold-Franzens-University Innsbruck and Chulalongkorn University Bangkok will put the partnership infrastructure developed by them at the disposal of the University of Vienna and the University of Chiang Mai. The representatives of both universities which have been in charge of the coordination of partnership activities should continue to do so also for the extended activities; in addition, both newly joined universities will nominate contact persons which are to be responsible for coordinating the activities within their institutions.

Each of the universities will carry the cost for guests staying at this university. In case both universities of one country are involved in partnership activities they will share the cost of domestic travel.


All the universities will endeavour to procure supplementary means from sources available in their countries for the performance of the activities within this extended partnership agreement.
